- Coordination of revision of parts activities (i.e., engineering changes, process changes, etc.)

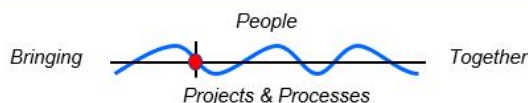
